

Proposed Amendment No. 1

A vote FOR this proposal will amend section 27 of Article 1 of the Nebraska Constitution to eliminate language requirements for private, denominational, and parochial schools.

A vote AGAINST this proposal will retain the current section of Article 1 of the Nebraska Constitution and will not eliminate language requirements for private, denominational, and parochial schools.

A constitutional amendment to clarify English language requirements in schools.

Proposed Amendment No. 2

A vote FOR this proposal will amend section 2 of the Article XIII of the Nebraska Constitution to permit the Legislature to authorize counties, cities, and villages to acquire, own, develop, lease, and otherwise finance real and personal property to be used by non profit enterprises. In addition, the Legislature would be empowered to authorize counties, cities and villages to issue revenue bonds for such purposes.

A vote AGAINST this proposal will retain the current section 2 of Article XIII of the Nebraska Constitution and will not grant authority to the Legislature as set forth above.

A constitutional amendment to authorize the use of revenue bonds to develop and lease property for use by nonprofit enterprises as determined by law.
